- WH Male 1950
Migraine since childhood
Usually 3-4 days per month
cannot leave the room
Herbal treatment started
September 2006
After 4 months no more migraines
- J.G. Male 1940
recurrent Herpes Simplex infections
of the eyes, strong headaches
Treatment in University clinic Vienna
no effect
Herbal treatment started in Dec. 2004
after one week infections were gone
- W.M. Female 1928
Bronchial Asthma infections of lungs
including pneumonia
Regular Cortisone treatments and monthly
antibiotics
Herbs and acupuncture started in May 2006
no more antibiotics needed

CASE STORIES

- **S.T. Male 1922**
PAV cannot walk due to pain in both legs
Hospital advises operation
Acupuncture started 10 years ago
Continues to do well
- **E.P. Male 1922**
Strong Bronchial Asthma since age 3
Chief of hospital urges Cortisone spray treatment
Herbal treatment and acupuncture started 2 years ago
still doing well today
- **P.E. Male 1946**
MDRI of leg near the hip in 2000
Many months of treatment with AB & morphine as painkiller with no success
Hospital recommends amputation
After one month of intensive treatment with herbs & laser & acupuncture
no more morphine or AB needed

- **WH male 1950**

Migraine since childhood

Usually 3,4 days per month not able to leave the room

Sep 2006 Herbal treatment after 4 month never an attack again

- **J.G male 1940**

Since years recurrent Herpes simplex infections of eyes, strong headaches

Treatment in university clinic Vienna no effect

Herbs begin in Dec 04 after one week no more Infection since today

- **W.M female 1928**

Bronchial Asthma recurrent Infections of lung even pneumonia

Regularly Cortisone treatment and Antibiotics nearly every month

Herbs & Acupuncture since Mai /06 no more Antibiotics needed

- **B.F. female 1948**

Broken Femur neck in Sep 07 operated with 4 , Ossatron treatment because no growing of the bone.

End of January 08 patient comes in wheelchair for first time.

Acupuncture, laser & herbal treatment, after two weeks patient comes already with crutches after 3 month bone is healed

- **Z.I female 1950**

Since 83 heart pacemaker because of arrhythmia strongly dilated heart dyspnoea extremely heavy climacteric difficulties (insomnia palpitation sweating)

First time treatment in Oct 06 December 06 Climacteric symptoms better as well as arrhythmia less medicine for the heart in January 07; Mai 07 can walk again in the mountain

In Sept 07 confirmation from the Italian cardiologist that all heart parameters like ECG, US are much better

- **B.K. female 1977**

Thyroid dysfunction since April 05; in spite of specialist treatment with strong medicine it is not possible to help her sufficiently; comes in October 05 and since June 06 no more medicine heeded until today

EFFECTIVE SINCE 1000's OF YEARS

Traditional Chinese medicine (TCM) originated in ancient China and has evolved over thousands of years. TCM practitioners use herbs, acupuncture, and other methods to treat a wide range of conditions. In the United States, TCM is considered part of complementary and alternative medicine (CAM). This fact sheet provides a general overview of TCM and suggests sources for additional information.

Traditional Chinese medicine, which encompasses many different practices, is rooted in the ancient philosophy of Taoism and dates back more than 5,000 years. Today, TCM is practiced side by side with Western medicine in many of China's hospitals and clinics.

Key Points

Herbal remedies and acupuncture are the treatments most commonly used by TCM practitioners. Other TCM practices include moxibustion, cupping, massage, mind-body therapy, and dietary therapy.

The TCM view of how the human body works, what causes illness, and how to treat illness is different from Western medicine concepts.

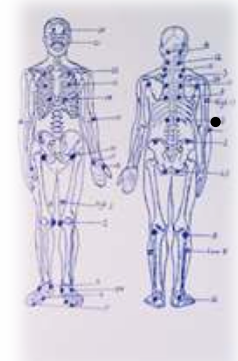
